OBTAIN THE REQUIRED 1 HOUR RENEWAL EDUCATION CLASS

Topics to be covered:

- Requirements to update and renew a commission.
- Maintaining a notarial journal.
- Explanation of electronic notarizations.
- Overview and examples of prohibited acts.
- Mandatory reporting that is required of a notary.

YOU CAN SUBMIT APPLICATION 3 MONTHS PRIOR TO EXPIRATION BUT BCI LETTER CAN ONLY BE 6 MONTHS OLD AND EDUCATION CERTIFICATE 12 MONTHS OLD.

NOTARY PUBLIC RENEWAL PROCESS:

- 1. Visit the Ohio Secretary of State's Notary website at https://ohiosos.gov/notary to apply to Renew your Notary. The law requires a formal criminal records check. Effective 4/6/23—peace officers do not need a BCI report. NOTE: The applicant must upload their OPOTA Certificate in lieu of the BCI report when submitting a notary renewal application.
- 2. Take an in-person or online class. Visit the Stark County Bar Association's website for information or visit the office to schedule your education class. (Steps 1 & 2 can be done simultaneously!) Once you have finished the education either in-person or online, you then notify the Secretary of State who will then send your notary commission to you once your application is approved.
- 3. Visit <u>www.Starkctybar.com</u> or visit the Stark County Bar Association for your notary supplies needs.
